## MINISTRY OF SURFACE TRANSPORT

New Delhi, the 20th September, 1988

G.S.R. 781.—In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution and in supersession of the Department of Lighthouses and Lightships (Non-Gazetted Non-Technical Posts) Recruitment Rules, 1962, and the Commercial Accountant in the Ministry of Transport (Transport Wing) Recruitment Rules, 1965, except as respect things done or omitted to be done before such supersession, the President hereby makes the following rules regulating the method of recruitment to certain Group 'C' and 'D' posts in the Department of Lighthouses and Lightships, namely :—

1. Short title and commencement.—(1) These rules may be called the Department of Lighthouses and Lightships (Group 'C' and Group 'D' Non-Technical posts) Recruitment Rules, 1988.

(2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.

2. Application.—These rules shall apply to the posts specified in column 1 of the Schedule annexed to these rules.

3. Number of posts, classification and scale of pay.—The number of the said posts, their classification and the scales of pay attached thereto shall be as specified in columns 2 to 4 of the said Schedule.

4. Method of Recruitment, age limit and other qualifications etc.—The method of recruitment to the said posts, age limit, qualifications and other matters relating thereto shall be as specified in columns 5 to 14 of the Schedule aforesaid.

5. Liability of persons appointed as peons to undergo training as Home Guards.—Notwithstanding anything contained in these rules, every person appointed as a Peon under

these rules shall undergo training as a Home Guard for a period of three years :

Provided that the Commandant General, Home Guards may, having regard to the performance and standard of training achieved by any person during the period of training, and for reason to be recorded in writing reduce such period to two years.

6. Disqualifications.—No person,—

- (1) who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living, or
- (2) who, having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person,

shall be eligible for appointment to any of the said posts:

Provided that the Central Government may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and the other party to the marriage and that there are other grounds for so doing, exempt any person from the operation of this rule.

7. Power to relax.—Where the Central Government is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do, it may, by order and for reasons to be recorded in writing, relax any of the provisions of these rules with respect to any class or category of persons.

8. Saving.—Nothing in these rules shall affect reservations, relaxation of age limit and other concessions required to be provided for the Scheduled Castes, the Scheduled Tribes, Ex-servicemen and other special categories of persons, in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Government from time to time in this regard.
